Continuous Synopsis Record (CSR) on Board

## **Purpose**

To establish guidelines with regards to the Continuous Synopsis Record - CSR as required by SOLAS Regulation XI-1/5, IMO Resolution A959 (23) and Resolution MSC.198 (80).

## **Application**

- 1. As of the 1st of July 2004, SOLAS Regulation XI-1/5 the following ships engaged on international voyages are required to keep on board a Continuous Synopsis Record CSR:
  - a. All passenger ships of 500 gross tonnage and above
  - b. Cargo ships of 500 gross tonnage and above
  - c. Mobile offshore drilling units (MODU)
- 2. Vessels that are not required to comply with the ISPS Code may apply voluntarily for the issuance of a Continuous Synopsis Record CSR.
- 3. Ship Owners / Managers / Operators, are expected to apply for issuance of a Continuous Synopsis Record CSR, through the responsible Registration Officer before Permanent Registration of the Vessel.
- 4. Along with an application for Change of Vessel's name and/or Vessel's Ownership and/or Bareboat Charterer and/or Recognized Organization and/or Classification Society and/or Vessel's Particulars and/or Application for Deletion, Owners/Operators/Managers are required to apply immediately for issuance of an updated Continuous Synopsis Record – CSR.
- 5. Required documents for issuance of CSR are the following:
  - a. Copy of application for CSR

- b. Copy of Class Certificate
- c. Copy of valid Document of Compliance (DOC)
- d. Copy of valid Safety Management Certificate (SMC)
- e. Copy of valid International Ship Security Certificate (ISSC)
- f. Copy of previous and/or last CSR
- g. Signed Quotation (where applicable)
- 6. This Administration reserves the right to deny issuance of CSR to any vessel not complying with this Maritime Circular and/or IMO Resolutions and/or IMO Conventions.
- 7. The above will enter into effect as of 12th January 2017.
