## Purpose

To Provide guidelines for the issuance or renewal of Bunker Convention Certificates.

#### Application

- 1. This procedure is applicable to all vessels over 1000 GT, of any type.
- 2. SLMARAD issues Bunker Convention Certificates to vessels registered under the Sierra Leone flag or registered under a Non State Party of the Convention.
- 3. SLMARAD does not issue Bunker Convention Certificates to vessels registered under another State Party of the Convention.
- 4. The documents to be submitted are:
  - a. Blue card addressed to SLMARAD as required in paragraph 5.
  - b. For vessels not registered under Sierra Leone flag the Certificate of Registry that belongs to another flag State.
  - c. Request and Acceptance of Service Form by the Registration Officer through the online "Fee Calculator" confirming the fees for the issuance or renewal of Bunker Convention Certificate.
- 5. The blue card must be addressed to:

### Sierra Leone Maritime Administration - Maritime House #6, Government Wharf Ferry Terminal, Freetown, Sierra Leone.

- 6. Blue card can be send in electronic format to SLMARAD through <u>bunker@slmarad.com</u>.
- 7. For the approved P&I Insurance Companies visit: <u>www.slmarad.com</u>.

- 8. Cancellation of Blue Cards and Bunker Certificates:
  - a. The approved P&I Insurance Companies shall notify the Administration when a cancellation of Blue Card occurs by sending an email to SLMARAD through <u>bunker@slmarad.com</u> within 24 hours of the cancellation.
  - b. The Administration shall inform the RegOff that Bunker Certificate has been cancelled in order to take necessary steps for reinstatement of the Bunker Certificate within 10 days.
  - c. All required documents for the reinstatement of the Bunker Certificate shall be submitted as per paragraph 4.
- 9. The above reporting system will enter into effect as of 10<sup>th</sup> of November 2016
