# Subject: Ballast Water Management Convention Urgent Reminder

#### Summary

MCI takes this opportunity to remind vessel managers that the Ballast Water Management Convention 2004, comes into force on 8 September 2017.

By 8 September 2017, all ships to which the BWMC applies, will be required to:

- Have an approved ballast water management plan on board (BWMC Annex, Section B-1),
- Maintain a ballast water record book (BWMC Annex, Section B-2),
- Manage their ballast water on every voyage by performing ballast water exchange (or by treating it using an approved ballast water treatment system), and
- Undertake an initial survey and be issued with an International BWM Certificate (for ships of 400 gross tonnage and above to which BWMC applies, excluding floating platforms, FSUs and FPSOs).

Any vessel that fails to comply with the requirements of the convention by 8 September will have its Certificate of Registration suspended until certification of compliance is established.

Any vessel that is not in compliance by 1 January 2018 will be deleted from the Register.
