<u>Subject:</u> Approval of Ballast Water Management Systems for Cook Islands-flagged vessels - Reminder

## <u>Summary</u>

Maritime Cook Islands (MCI) would like to remind all interested parties that <u>MCI Circular</u> <u>221/2020</u> issued on January 2020 requires that every Ballast Water Management System (BWMS) to be installed onboard of Cook Islands-flagged vessel, shall be issued with a Type Approval according to below schedule:

- <u>Type Approval issued by MCI</u>: Manufacturers shall submit the type approval request to one of the Cook Islands IACS Recognized Organization (list can be found on the MCI website, <u>https://www.maritimecookislands.com/maritime-cook-islands/survey-and-certification/recognised-organizations/</u>), that at the end of the approval process will issue a Type Approval Certificate of BWMS on behalf of the Cook Islands Administration.
- <u>Type Approval issued by another Administration</u>, under Res. MEPC.279(70) G8 or MEPC. 300(72) – BWMS Code: Manufacturers shall submit a copy of the Type Approval Certificate together with a type-approval report according to Part 7.2 of the Annex of either Guidelines G8 or BWMS Code, whichever is applicable. MCI will issue a Type Approval Certificate on a case-by-case basis, based on the approval already carried out by the other Administration, with the same validity of the certificate the approval was based on.
