## Summary

Maritime Cook Islands would like to draw your attention to the press release of the Paris and the Tokyo Memoranda of Understanding (MoU) on Port State Control (attached below), regarding a joint Concentrated Inspection Campaign (CIC) which will be carried out at all Paris, Tokyo, Indian Ocean Black Sea MoU and Viña del Mar Ports with the purpose to ensure compliance with SOLAS Chapter II-1.

The campaign will be held for three months, commencing from 1 September 2013 and ending on 30 November 2013.

Shipowners and agents thereof are advise to take note of this information and ensure action is taken to ensure compliance and that crew is familiar with safety and emergency procedures.
